The Smithsonian Nisei Soldier Congressional Gold Medal Digital Exhibition

Now Online

The National Veterans Network, Smithsonian's National Museum of American History and the Smithsonian Asian Pacific American Center have launched "The Nisei Soldier Congressional Gold Medal" digital online exhibition centered on the outstanding military service of Nisei soldiers during WWII, including those who served in combat, in supporting roles and as part of the Japan Occupation. The online exhibition tells the life stories of 12 soldiers, and was launched on May 12, 2016. Additionally, a video about the Nisei Soldiers and introduction of the digital exhibition have now been added to the Nisei Soldier Congressional Gold Medal display in the Price of Freedom: Americans at War exhibition in the Smithsonian's National Museum of American History in Washington DC, providing exposure to millions of visitors each year. – Dan Yoshii, Japan-America Society of Southern Colorado
