The fourth of July marks the 250 year anniversary of the signing of our nation's Declaration of Independence, and August 1st is the Colorado statehood 150th anniversary. Colorado became the 38th state in the United States on August 1, 1876. President Ulysses S. Grant signed the proclamation for statehood 100 years after the Declaration of Independence, which is why Colorado is known as the "Centennial State."
